

Due to increased amount of appliances and garbage that have been illegally dumped at our SARCAN location, we feel the need to remind our community about what electronics can be recycled at Estevan SARCAN.

What is accepted? (DURING HOURS OF OPERATION, Monday- Friday, 8:30-4:30)

Computers, Monitors and Accessories: laptops, tablets, CPUs (towers), desktop servers, CRT monitors, flat panel monitors and automotive displays as well as keyboards, mice, speakers, external modems/routers, external drives, and scanners.

Desktop Printers and Fax Machines: Inkjet printers, laser/toner printers, dot matrix printers, all-in-one (multi-function) printers, photo printers, label printers, and desktop photocopiers.

Televisions, including CRT and flat panel televisions, closed-circuit displays, and TV/VCR or DVD combinations.

Audio Equipment, including stereos (home and automobile), speakers (home, automobile, and MP3 docking speakers), headphones, microphones, portable music players (CD, cassette, MP3), voice recorders, radios, alarm clock radios, and turntables.

Video Equipment, including VCRs, DVD players, portable DVD players, personal video recorders (PVRs), satellite receivers, cable receivers, personal data assistants (PDAs), and digital picture frames.

Cameras, including film cameras, digital cameras, video cameras, web cameras, and security cameras.

Telephones, including corded and cordless telephones, cellular and smart phones, satellite telephones, VOIP telephones, pagers, beepers, and answering machines.

Under no circumstances do we recycle:

Microwave ovens, air conditioners, washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, water coolers, power tools, vacuum cleaners, barbeques, strollers, and car seats.

These items that are left at SARCAN have to be properly disposed of by staff of Estevan Diversified Services and SARCAN. Please be reminded that there are financial costs to removing these items from our property. A surveillance camera will soon be installed to ensure this no longer happens.

Abandoned garbage causes health and environmental risks, encourages more illegal dumping, and sends a message that illegal activity is okay in your neighbourhood.

When you dispose of items properly, and when you report illegal dumping, you help improve the quality of life in your neighbourhood.
